Genus & Species:	<i>Sempervivum hybrid</i>
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	Zone 3. (-40°F or -40°C).
Bloom:	Foliage selection, slow to flower. Pink star shaped flowers, held in clusters, on stout fleshy stems.
Bloom Time:	Mid-late summer.
Foliage:	Colorful symmetrical rosette. Deep purple in color. Deepest foliage color in full sun. This selection has excellent year round foliage color. As strong in summer as winter.
Habit:	Large single rosette. 8” x 8”.
Propagation:	TC & Offsets. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun for best color.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Common name: Hen and Chicks.
Uses:	Low-water Containers, Garden Border, Xeriscape landscapes.

1 Gallon:	6-8 weeks
2 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
