<b>Bloom:</b>	Two rows of flat petals, red-bronze in color with a cream border. Blooms are colorfast & age well. Blooming over an exceptionally long period.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early spring– fall. Blooms non-stop in UK!
<b>Foliage:</b>	Fresh gray green hairy foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mounding habit 14” x 14”
<b>Propagation:</b>	Root Cuttings / Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun, well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, beds, borders.

<b>1 Quart:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks</b>
<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>12-14 weeks</b>

### Comparison: G. ‘Burgundy’

### Key Differences:

- ✓ ‘Sunset Cutie’ tight compact habit **vs.** more open habit.
- ✓ ‘Sunset Cutie’ higher bud count **vs.** lower bud count.
- ✓ ‘Sunset Cutie’ longer flowering period **vs.** shorter period.
