USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Single rows of flat petals, purple-pink in color with cream/yellow tips. Blooms are colorfast & age well. Blooming over an exceptionally long period.
Bloom Time:	Early spring– fall. Blooms non-stop in UK!
Foliage:	Fresh gray green hairy foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 16” x 16”
Propagation:	Root Cuttings / Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, beds, borders.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	12-14 weeks

Comparison: G. ‘Burgundy’

Key Differences:

- ✓ ‘Sunset Snappy’ tight compact habit **vs.** more open habit.
- ✓ ‘Sunset Snappy’ higher bud count **vs.** lower bud count.
- ✓ ‘Sunset Snappy’ longer flowering period **vs.** shorter period.
