Foliage:	Aromatic, small, fresh light green foliage.
Habit:	Dwarf tight rounded habit. 8" x 8". (Unlike the species 16" x 16").
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Ideal for pots and containers. Ideal for 6 pack promotional sales.
Uses:	Pots & containers, garden border, modern mass landscape plantings.
