Characteristics

Genus & Species:Achillea millefoliumProtection Status:US Plant Patent 32,932.USDA Zone:USDA Zone 3. (-40°F or -40°C).

Bloom: Large and colorfast rich ruby red blooms held high on strong stems. Long lasting blooms.

Bloom Time: Early-summer through fall.

Foliage: Attractive, fern-like lemon foliage. **Habit:** Tight clumping habit. 18" x 14".

Propagation: Tip cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Well-drained soil in full sun. Trim back spent blooms to encourage new growth & repeat fall

blooming. Responds well to being cut back hard for fresh new lemon foliage.

Additional Comments: A robust drought resistant perennial once established. Deer resistant. Wind resistant. Humidity

tolerant. Attracts butterflies. Salt tolerant. Great for cut or dried flower. Common name is Yarrow.

Uses: Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape, long-lasting cut or dried flower.
