Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Colocasia esculenta</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 23,896.
USDA Zone:	Zone 7b-11. (5°F or -14°C).
Bloom:	Foliage selection. Spath/spadix inflorescence.
Foliage:	Elegant glossy dark black foliage held on dark petioles.
Habit:	Tidy, clump forming habit with short runners developing close to the mother plant. 48 x 36" at maturity. Makes an ideal 6" pot 16" x 12".
Propagation:	TC / division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Moist rich well drained soil in full sun to part shade. 50°F nights and 70-80°F (or warmer) days.
Additional Comments:	Excess high nitrogen or drying out can cause foliage burn.
Uses:	Large containers, garden borders, mass landscape planting.

1 Quart:	8-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	12-16 weeks
