

Tricyrtis Ninja Star = 'Kristen'

Key Features

- ✓ Colorful broad yellow leaf margins.
- ✓ Attractive purple spotted flower with yellow throats.
- ✓ Excellent garden presence.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Tricyrtis formosana

Protection Status: PP 33,439

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28.9°C).

Bloom: Star like, lilly flowers. Base color white, flushed and spotted pink to deep purple, with attractive

warm vellow throats.

Bloom Period: Midsummer (August-September).

Foliage: Heavy leaf substance appearing dark green with colorful broad yellow leaf margins. Foliage

lightens through the season, with the yellow lightening.

Habit: Tidy clumping habit 12-18" x 12". Mature colonies 18" tall x 36" wide. **Propagation:** Cuttings, division or Tissue culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Moist, humus rich soils in light to full shade.

Additional Comments: Common Name: Toad Lilly. Plants will form tidy colonies when happy to 36" wide.

Sport from Tricyrtis 'Samurai'

Uses: Shade containers, Shade beds, borders and landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 12-14 weeks 2 Gallon: 16-18 weeks

Comparison: T. 'Samurai' Key Differences:

- ✓ Ninja Star broader yellow leaf margins vs. lighter green yellow leaf margins.
- ✓ **Ninja Star** brighter appearance vs. more subdued appearance.
- ✓ Ninja Star great garden presence vs. great garden presence.
